ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Recipient must be a Columbus, OH or Franklin County High School student.
- Recipient is accepted, and will be attending their first year of Undergraduate School in the fall of 2017

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must submit the following by July 17th:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- One to three (1-3) page typed essay
- An official and complete copy of High School transcripts
- A copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited University within the United States
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (i.e., birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)

AWARD:

- Scholarship Award is to be used exclusively for university tuition and related expenses.
- A check for \$1,500 will be made payable to the award recipient's school to cover these expenses.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.
- **DEADLINE:** Completed applications must be submitted no later than July 17th, 2107. Application materials should be emailed in PDF format to koenigandlong@gmail.com.
